



SEAONC STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM - 2024

SEAONC is pleased to announce its Student Scholarship Program (Program), which provides support to university students pursuing a career in structural engineering. This year SEAONC, partnered with Computer and Structures, Inc. (CSI), will award between two (2) and seven (7) scholarships, up to \$5,000 each, for use toward tuition, books, supplies, and living expenses incurred during the academic year. The Program submittal requirements, submittal process, evaluation criteria, and award description are described in this document.

The Program is currently limited to these California universities:

California Polytechnic University at San Luis Obispo
San Francisco State University
San Jose State University
Santa Clara University
Stanford University
University of California at Berkeley
University of the Pacific

Eligible candidates include undergraduate students (including students transferring from community college) and graduate students who:

- 1) will be enrolled in a structural engineering degree program or
- 2) will be enrolled in a civil engineering program with structural focus

for the 2024 fall term at one of the institutions listed above. The applicant will confirm their interest in structural engineering as part of the personal statement.

Program Evaluation and Grading Criteria

The SEAONC Scholarship Committee will review all applications. Copies of all applications may be shared with the SEAONC Board of Directors. The submission of an application indicates that the applicant permits distribution to these groups.

Scholarship awards will be granted using the Committee's subjective evaluation of the applicant's stated interest in the structural engineering profession, education plans, academic performance, involvement in organizations/chapters/clubs/activities, demonstrated leadership qualities, and ties to northern California.

Scholarship Awards

Applicants will be notified of award by April 14, 2024. The SEAONC Past President will invite all scholarship award recipients to attend the SEAONC Awards Dinner Meeting, held at the San Francisco War Memorial & Performing Arts Center on May 7, 2024. Each scholar recipient will be individually introduced to the meeting attendees. Arrangements for guest attendance will be managed by the SEAONC office.

Scholarship payment will be sent to award recipients upon receipt of written confirmation of enrollment in one of the listed universities for the 2024 Fall term.
