### **Project 1: Evaluation of Water Quality Impacts Related to Rocket Launch Activities and Outreach to Tribes and Underrepresented Communities**

#### **Summary of Duties:**

- Research and compile information regarding rocket launch-related residual wastes that may affect water quality.
- Compile and evaluate available groundwater and surface water information from existing rocket-launch locations in the Central Coast Region.
- Compile available information regarding how other states may monitor water quality or permit discharges related to rocket launches.
- Prepare an annotated bibliography of available data and information.
- Compile a list of federal, state, and local agencies who have jurisdiction over the environmental impacts related to rocket launches on the Central Coast
- Identify and evaluate existing opportunities for public participation and make recommendations to improve community outreach and engagement.

- Assessment of regional groundwater basins based on available data.
- Review of existing regional groundwater monitoring wells.
